CALL TO WORSHIP:

ADVENT CANDLE LIGHTING LITANY:

Reader 1: Here we are, gathered together to tell once again, the old, old, story of how God came to us on that first Christmas! It is a night of stories and songs, that we might enter the holy mystery of Emmanuel, God-with-us.

We tell and sing of shepherds, and angels, and inns that have no room. And of the babe who is birthed in a stable, and laid in a manger.

Reader 2: As we awaited this night we have been counting down the weeks, lighting candles to push back the dark, and brighten our hearts. We have lit Candles of Hope, Peace, Joy and Love. And now the wait is over. For unto us is born this night, as he was so long ago, a Saviour who is Christ the Lord!

[The Christ Candle is lit]

**We honour Messiah with Christ Candle's flame,

SHARING THE LIGHT OF CHRIST

A choir member will come down and light the candle of the person at the end of the row. They will say: *The Light of Christ has come!* The response may be: *Amen!* This continues as you light the candle of the person next to you, and so on. When everyone's candle is lit, we will sing together: **Silent Night** – words are printed in bulletin.

(Note: slide the cup down the candle for the purpose of lighting. Once lit, slide the cup up to fully enclose the flame. The person with the lit candle should hold it upright, and the unlit candle can be tipped to receive the light.)
