GREEN TIP: Recipe for Air Freshener: 1 small Mason jar, ¾ cup of baking soda, 5 – 10 drops of essential oil (not absolutely necessary), a small piece of breathable fabric. Measure baking soda into Mason jar, add the essential oil. Cut a round piece of material, put on top of jar or in the ring of the cover. Put ring on jar. Shake up every 3 to 4 days, replace every 6 to 7 weeks. Spray Air Freshener: 10 drops of essential oil, ¼ cup of witch hazel, 1 cup filtered water. Fill spray bottle with the witch hazel and water, add oil, shake a couple of times and its ready to use.
