GREEN TIP: A Green Tip From The Confirmands: Jess Tupling, Amber and Emma Knorr:

Plastic drinking straws are a cylinder—one of the strongest geometrical shapes, regardless of the material they're made out of—because they disperse stress throughout their entire form. It's no surprise then that plastic straws are dangerous to wildlife. Because they are small, straws are often mistaken for food by animals and because of their shape, straws can cause suffocation and death to the animal. Please consider using one of the new – and really cool! – alternatives: permanent drinking straws made of stainless steel, bamboo, etc.

IN CASE OF FIRE

NEW MARYLAND UNITED CHURCH

- *** If a fire occurs, activate a fire pull station (near exit doors) and leave the building immediately. Fire Department will be notified automatically.
- *** The primary exit for basement occupants (kitchen area & Sunday School room) will be the OLD rear door. Nursery room use either the OLD rear door or the MAIN ENTRANCE.
- *** The primary exit for the Choir, Minister, & occupants of "rear side" pews will be the MAIN (rear parking lot) ENTRANCE.
- *** The primary exit for occupants of the rear pews will be the ROAD ENTRANCE.
- *** Sunday School teachers will be responsible for getting the children out safely. Parents should not block the stairs by going to the basement.
- *** DO NOT ATTEMP TO USE THE LIFT —a power failure could result in someone becoming trapped inside it. Those with mobility concerns MUST use ROAD ENTRANCE where the ramp is.
- *** After evacuating the church building, the main assembly area will be the rear parking lot, well clear of the building.
