GREEN TIP: During the month of March, our green tips will focus on "green spring cleaning". Here are a few tips to help you on your way to a clean "green" house.

Toilet bowl cleaner: Sprinkle a toilet brush with baking soda and scrub away! Occasionally disinfect your toilet by scrubbing with borax instead. Wipe the outside of the toilet with straight vinegar.

Disinfectant: Mix two teaspoons borax, four tablespoons vinegar, three cups hot water and ½ teaspoon liquid castile soap. Wipe on dampened cloth or use a spray bottle. Wipe clean.
