Glass- Mix ¼ cup vinegar with one quart of water in a spray bottle. Spray on glass and wipe clean with old newspaper or a lint-free cloth.

Countertops and bathrooms tile – Mix two parts vinegar and one part baking soda with four parts water. Apply with a sponge, scour and wipe away.
