SHARING THE LIGHT OF CHRIST

A choir member will come down and light the candle of the person at the end of the row. When everyone's candle is lit, we will sing together: Silent Night. (*Note: slide the cup down the candle for the purpose of lighting. Once lit, slide the cup up to fully enclose the flame. The person with the lit candle should hold it upright, and the unlit candle can be tipped to receive the light.)*
