### **Introduction to The Sacrament (From:** A Song of Faith):

In grateful response to God's abundant love, we bear in mind our integral connection to the earth and one another;

To point to the presence of the holy in the world,

the church receives, consecrates, and shares visible signs of the grace of God.

In company with the churches of the Reformed and Methodist traditions, we celebrate two sacraments as gifts of Christ: baptism and holy communion.

#### Call for choral enthusiasts:

The Fredericton Choral Society (FCS) is excited to present Carl Orff's *Carmina Burana* in May 2020. This iconic work of 20<sup>th</sup> century choral music is set to twenty-four of the *Carmina Burana*, a 13<sup>th</sup> century compilation of secular poetry and song whose irreverence and emotional candour startle even today. A larger choir is required to realise the power of this tremendous work, which will be presented with the rarely performed chamber orchestration for two pianists and a percussion ensemble of five players.

Weekly rehearsals begin January 7th at St. Paul's Church at the corner of George and York Streets, starting at 7:15 p.m. The concert will take place on May 9th, at the Tom Morrison Theatre, Fredericton High School.

The FCS is Fredericton's longstanding gender-inclusive community choir, which welcomes amateur singers of all levels of experience. Its artistic director and conductor, Heather Fyffe, is a noted musician, pianist/organist, conductor, and educator in the Fredericton area.

Term fees have increased slightly this term to facilitate the performance of this ambitious piece. Fees are \$65 per person (\$20 for students) and \$85 per family/couple, but we are happy to accommodate anyone who wishes to sing with us. The Fredericton Choral Society is a registered charity and we welcome community contributions through our donation page at <a href="mailto:canadahelps.org">canadahelps.org</a>. The FCS has an added incentive for new members—if you are new to the choir and you bring a friend who is also new, you will be charged the family rate, a savings of \$22.50 each!
