THE WORD OF GOD

THE SCRIPTURE LESSON: Exodus 14

When Pharaoh was told that the Israelites had fled, he said, 'What have we done, letting Israel leave our service?' So he had his chariot made ready, and took his army with him;

The Israelites looked back, and there were the Egyptians advancing on them. In great fear the Israelites cried out to the Lord.

But Moses said to the people, 'Do not be afraid, stand firm, and see the deliverance that the Lord will accomplish for you today; The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to keep still.'

Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Why do you cry out to me? Tell the Israelites to go forward. But you lift up your staff, and stretch out your hand over the sea and divide it, that the Israelites may go into the sea on dry ground.
