THE WORD OF GOD

THE OLD TESTAMENT LESSON: Exodus 16: 1-15

The entire community of the Children of Israel came to the wilderness of Syn. It was on the fifteenth day after the second New- Moon, after their going-out from the land of Egypt. And they grumbled.

They grumbled against Moses and against Aaron. They said: Would that we have died in the land of Egypt. There we sat by the fleshpots and ate bread till we were satisfied. For you have brought us into the wilderness to bring death to this whole assembly by starvation!

Then the Lord said to Moses: I will make bread from the heavens to rain

down upon you. The people shall go out and glean only each day's amount. But on the sixth day it shall be a double portion.
