**GREEN COMMITTEE** – Have you heard of, "Beat the Peak"?

N. B. Power launched a challenge between Fredericton/New Maryland and Moncton/ Dieppe/ Riverview, to cut down on energy use during "peak" hours. Peak hours occur between 6-9 AM and 4-8 PM. The challenge runs from **Jan. 19<sup>th</sup> - Feb. 6**. The community with the highest rate of participation (per capita) will receive an investment of \$10,000 in energy savings at their local YMCA. You can log on at "beatthepeak.ca" where you can share your energy saving habits on the website and social media. Here, as well, you will have a chance to win weekday and weekly prizes. The goal is to use less energy during these hours, maybe we could do our laundry after 8 PM.
