**GREEN TIP: Tick deterrent for pets:** 1 C. water, 2 C. white vinegar, 2 Tbsp. vegetable or almond oil. Spray on your pet's dry coat, avoiding eyes and mouth. Repeat every 4 hours if pet is outside. **For people**, use the same mixture, using 20 drops of essential oil (eucalyptus, citrus, peppermint) instead of vegetable oil. Spray on clothing, skin, hair. Repeat every 4 hours.
