GREEN COMMITTEE – Cellophane has been around for more than a century, & we still buy products (especially food) wrapped in cellophane. Although it gives the appearance of plastic, it is actually made from plant matter (cellulose). Therefore it should NOT be put in the "blue recycling box", as it is NOT plastic.

Cellophane biodegrades in approximately 90 days. It is broken down by micro-organisms in the soil, just as leaves & plants are.

Cellophane is an example of a more environmentally-conscious way of packaging consumer goods, & can actually be buried in your compost pile.
